• Academic Leadership:

- Provide academic and administrative leadership for graduate programs, including PhD programs (Accounting, Analytics, Information & Operations, Finance, Management, and Marketing), MBA programs (full-time, hybrid, and online), and MS programs (Business Analytics, Organizational Leadership, and Supply Chain Management).
- Successfully developed and launched an innovative Master's in Business Analytics program, navigating its approval through the Kansas Board of Regents. Directed the program's curriculum development, faculty selection, and recruitment of the inaugural student cohort prior to eventually hiring a full-time recruiter.
- Spearheaded the creation of a STEM-certified dual MBA/MS in Business Analytics degree, expanding interdisciplinary offerings and enhancing the recruitment of international students.
- Simultaneously served as Associate Dean *and* Area Director of Analytics, Information, and Operations for 2.5 years, balancing administrative leadership with active research and graduate mentorship roles.

• Budget and Personnel Management:

- Oversaw an annual operating and personnel budget exceeding \$2 million..
- Supervised a team of seven staff members supporting a diverse cohort of 700+ graduate students.

• Enrollment Growth and Program Enhancement:

- Led the continuous revitalization of the online MBA program in collaboration with staff, faculty, and the online program manager (OPM), achieving a 133% enrollment increase from 2019 to 2024.
- Worked with all stakeholders (faculty, staff, OPM) to enhance the quality and national reputation of the online MBA program, culminating in a national #7 ranking by U.S. News & World Report in 2025 – an improvement from #31 in 2020.
- Hired a full-time graduate student recruiter, contributing to a 57% enrollment growth across all MBA and MS programs from 2019 to 2024.

- Designed and launched a hybrid MBA program tailored to military officers, strategically increasing enrollment.

Facilitated extensive collaboration between the Schools of Business and Engineering, leading the workforce development component and participating in all NSF reviews and presentations to the blue-ribbon panel. Securing the grant was a multi-year process which involved working with over 40 research faculty at at KU, as well as the universities of Maryland, Lehigh, Notre Dame, South Dakota, and Hawai'i.
